Section 3xxxx Do Not Block Intersection Marking

Option:

Do Not Block Intersection markings may be used to mark the edges of the intersection area where there is a highway intersection in close proximity to a signalized intersection and where vehicles might stop within the intersection and impede other traffic entering the intersection.

Standard:

If used, Do Not Block Intersection markings shall consist of 12 inch solid white lines that form a box to delineate the edges of the intersection where vehicles should not stop or impede other traffic entering the intersection. Do Not Block Intersection markings shall not be used unless accompanied by a Do Not Block Intersection (R10-7) sign.

Option:

Word markings such as, "DO NOT BLOCK INTERSECTION", may be used in conjunction with the Do Not Block Intersection Marking and sign, consistent with Section 3B.19.
